- **WHEN:** Thursday, March 23, 2023 and Tuesday, April 4, 2023
- **WHO:** Children in grades K-12 who need vaccinations to meet school requirements
- **TIME:** Appointments available between 3:00-4:30 PM
- **WHERE:** Carlton County Community Services Building- 14 North 11th Street, Cloquet, MN
- **COST:** NO COST. Insurance information will be collected and billed if the child is insured; NO CHARGE if the child is uninsured or if insurance doesn't cover the cost of vaccines.

Available Vaccines: (Click on the vaccine for the current Vaccine Information Statements or visit: [cdc.gov/vaccines/hcp/vis/index.html](https://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/hcp/vis/index.html))

- **DTaP/Polio** – Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis & polio (up through age 6)
- **Hep B** – Hepatitis B (up through age 18)
- **MMRV** – Measles, mumps, rubella & varicella (up through age 12)
- **Tdap***- Tetanus, diphtheria & pertussis (ages 10 and older)
- **MenACWY****- Meningococcal conjugate (ages 10 and older)
- **HPV+** – Human Papillomavirus vaccine (ages 11 and older)
